Scholarship Criteria:

- 1. Students must be in the top 25% of the graduating class.
- 2. The Education Foundation will review and compare the applicants' records with regards to the student's commitment to the community in the areas of extra curricular activities, leadership, and community service.
- 3. Students are required to submit a 200 + word essay *describing exactly what they did in their volunteer organization, and briefly what the value was to them.*
- 4. Students must be able to have their volunteer hours certified.
- 5. Students need to complete the attached application and list the college of their choice and the estimated cost of attending the college.
- 6. Students are encouraged to attach a resume or bio that contains information related to the application questions.
